### Basic Requirements

- 8½ x 11 sheet of paper: any color.
- The word "Wanted" at the top of your paper.
- A *drawing* of your organ.
- Which organ system contains your organ?
- What is your organ's main function(s)?
- How does your organ work to keep your body healthy?
- What diseases or disorders affect your organ?
- Can a person live without your organ?
- Your name in the bottom right corner.
- All information on one page.
- Poster must be neat and information easy to find .
- Place your poster on a piece of construction paper.

Make sure you don't leave anything out. Use this checklist as you work.
